A Timeline of Paul's Ministry in Galatians and Acts. **David Huffstutler** Date Description Galatians Acts Saul (not yet Paul) persecuted the church. AD 34 1:13-14 9:1-2 AD 34 Saul was converted. 1:15-16a 9:3-19a AD 34-37 Saul preached in Arabia and Damascus. 1:17 9:19-22; cf. 9:27 Saul visited Jerusalem three years after his AD 37 1:18-20 9:26-29 conversion. AD 37-47 Saul preached in Syria and Cilicia. 1:21-24 9:30-31 AD 47 Saul visited Jerusalem fourteen years after his 2:1-10 11:27-30? conversion. AD 47-48 Saul became Paul and with Barnabas planted 13:1-14:28 churches in Gentile territory, Galatia included, during Paul's first missionary journey. AD 48 Peter visited Antioch and was confronted by 2:11-14 Paul wrote Galatians. AD 48 1:1-6:18 AD 49 Paul participated in the Apostolic Council in 15:1-29 Jerusalem. AD 49-51 Paul and Silas visited the Galatian churches 16:6; cf. 15:40-18:22 during Paul's second missionary journey. AD 52-57 Paul visited the Galatian churches for the last 18:23; cf. 18:23-21:17 time recorded in Scripture.
