- 7. An ability to recruit, develop and shepherd those involved in the worship ministry.
- 8. A strong upfront leader with gifts and abilities to create a worship environment that touches the heart of the believer and draws the seeker to Christ.

- 10. Ability to operate, with the help of our AV techs, A/V and musical equipment related to services and perform simple troubleshooting tasks as needed.

Responsibilities:

- 2. Lead the musical aspects of worship:
 - a. Oversee the selection and preparation of all music and song sets
 - b. Coordinate and lead worship teams
 - c. Coordinate music with sound and computer technicians
 - d. Schedule any special music and all personnel for services
 - e. To monitor necessary equipment for worship services and report any equipment in need of repairs
 - f. Develop and coordinate the music ministry calendar with musicians and sound personnel
 - g. Train and maintain a technical A/V staff to handle computer presentations and sound equipment
